A message from Mrs McGann

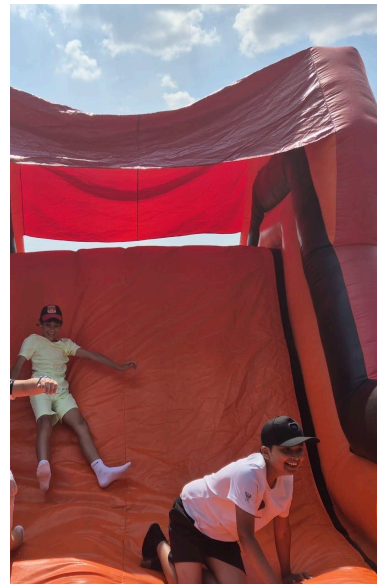

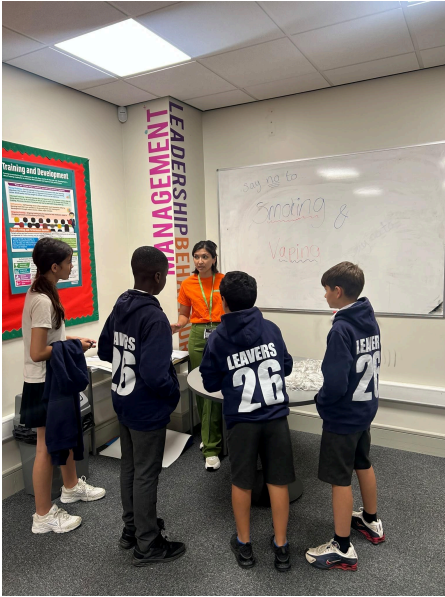
