- Games, toys, puzzles, and other suitable fair prizes

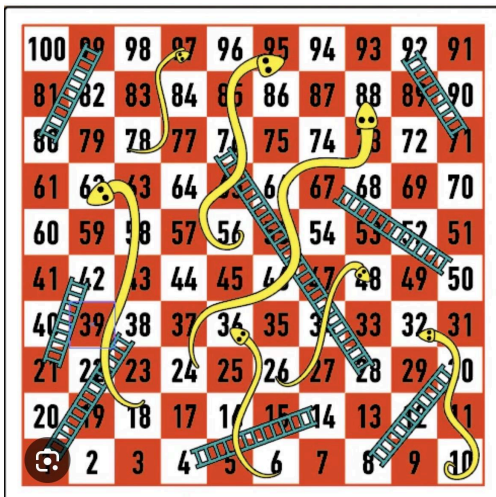

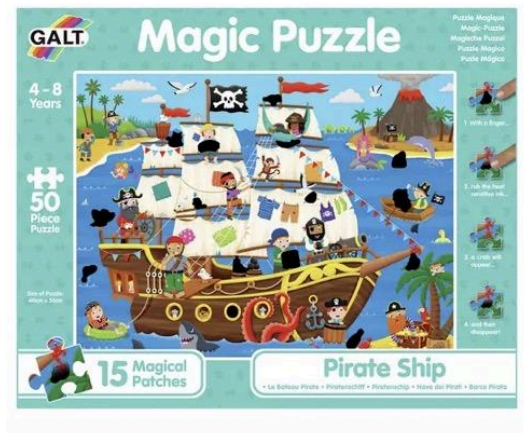

## Martial Arts day



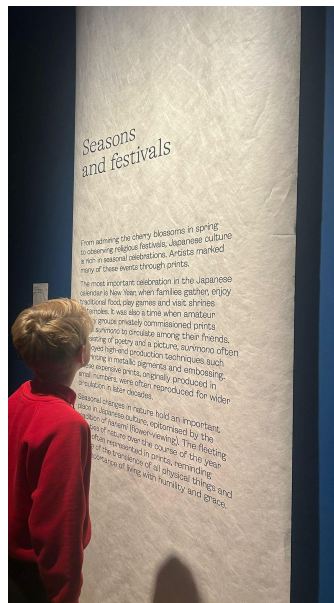
