During the trip, they admired the beautiful stained-glass windows, and discovered fascinating facts about the Minster's history and architecture.

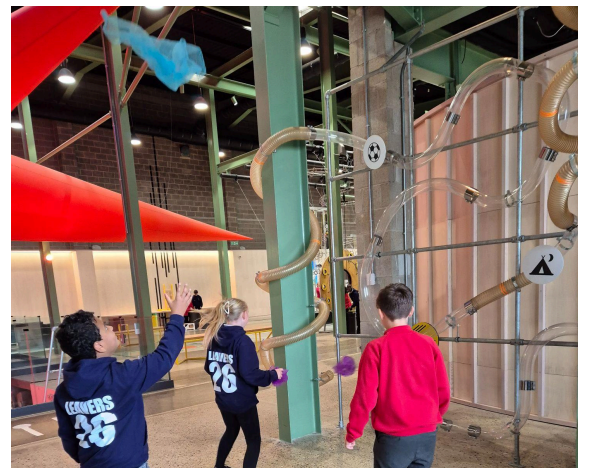


York Sightseeing Bus - Key Stage One

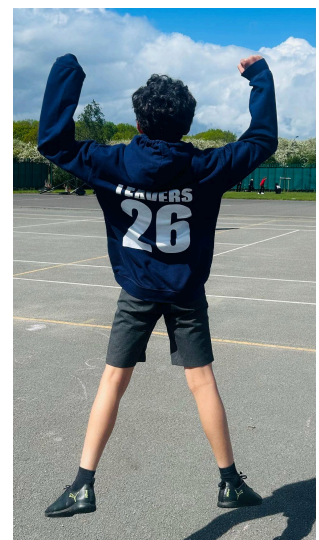


We would like to say how incredibly proud we are of all our Year 6 pupils following SATS week.
