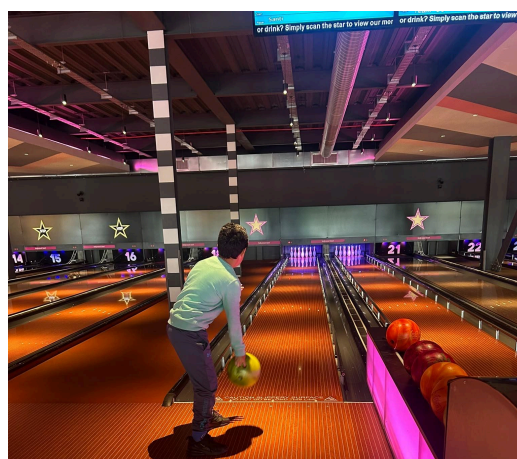
What a fantastic time our Squirrels and Hares had at their recent PizzaExpress workshop!
