School has been filled with the sound of music this half term.



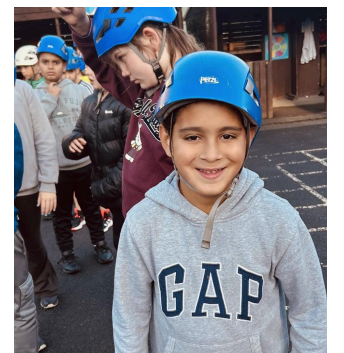
