Choose at least one option from these homework activities and hand it in to Mrs McGann by Friday 20th March, for us to celebrate in school.



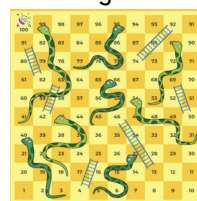
It is safer internet day on Tuesday 10th February. Can you write your top tips for staying safe online?
